


## EMERGENCY AND DISASTER RESPONSE



### DEPARTMENT OF DISASTER MANAGEMENT AND EMERGENCIES (DDME)



During an actual emergency the department is responsible for providing warning and coordinating the response and support to government departments and private sector recovery efforts.

The Department Disaster Managment and Emergencies does not offer MHPSS Services as it primarily serves as a coordinating mechanism in disasters. They may make referrals to other agencies as needed.
