


ACUTE PSYCHIATRIC UNIT DOMINICA CHINA FRIENDSHIP HOSPITAL

The Acute Psychiatric Unit provides mental health care to all Dominicans of all ages. Its main function is the assessment, diagnosis and treatment of patients in an acute care setting. Additionally we provide Consultation Liaison Psychiatry service to the Dominica China Friendship Hospital including crisis management and critical incidents which extends to the Primary Health Care Services, communities and other government services. We also provide mental health services to the communities in Dominica through a referral system with the Primary Health Care Services.


BUREAU OF GENDER AFFAIRS

OFFICE OF DISASTER MANAGEMENT

The Office of Disaster Management coordinates the implementation of Comprehensive Disaster Management (CDM) in the Commonwealth of Dominica through the National Emergency Planning Organization (NEPO), a governmental organization with responsibility for the planning and organization of counter-disaster measures at central level.

The Office of Disaster Management does not offer MHPSS Services as it primarily serves as a coordinating mechanism in disasters. They may make referrals to other agencies as needed.
